

gina brezini has devoted her entire life to making art. An artistic child in Bulgaria, she began her training at the age of 12, followed by studies at The Fine Arts High School and The National Academy of Fine Arts. Gina lives in New York City and works in mixed-media art forms.



Gina Brezini was awarded the 1st Prize Lorenzo di Medici in Florence in 2005, and The Prize for Graphics and Photography at the Biennale Austria in 2006. In 2008 Elite Art Publishing in Paris released a monograph featuring her art, with an introduction by Nicolas Bourriaud. In 2009 Brezini was included in a project featuring ten of the most distinguished women artists in India. She was the only foreign artist selected to participate. The goal of the project was to acknowledge the creative contribution of women in contemporary art. The works

were simultaneously exhibited in prestigious galleries in New Delhi, Mumbai and Bangalore and were accompanied by the book *Dus Mahavidyas, Ten Creative Forces*.

In 2010 Gina Brezini showed her artwork in Venice, London, Monaco and Grand Palais in Paris, France. In 2011 Museo Epicentro in Italy acquired a painting for the permanent collection of the museum.

Federation National de la culture Française selected her painting *Memoires of the Flesh* as the recipient of the award *Toile d'or de l'an 2011*.



Gina Brezini is actively exhibiting in galleries in New York, Los Angeles, San Francisco, Tokyo, India and Europe. Her work is in many public, corporate and private collections around the world.
